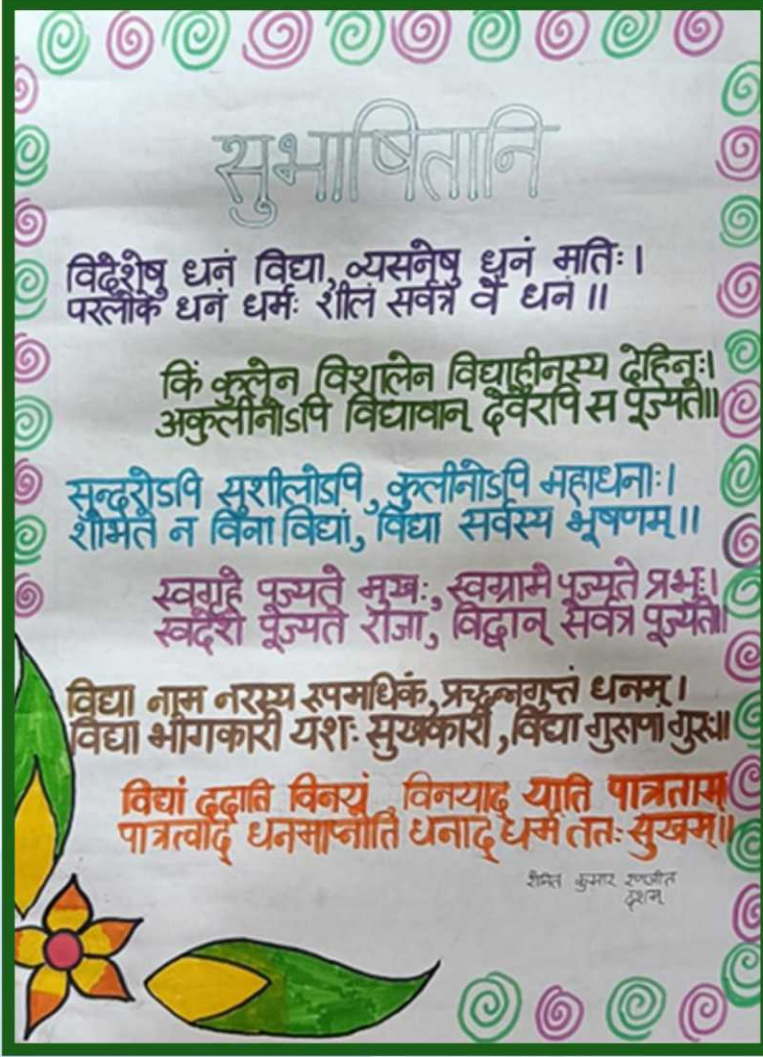

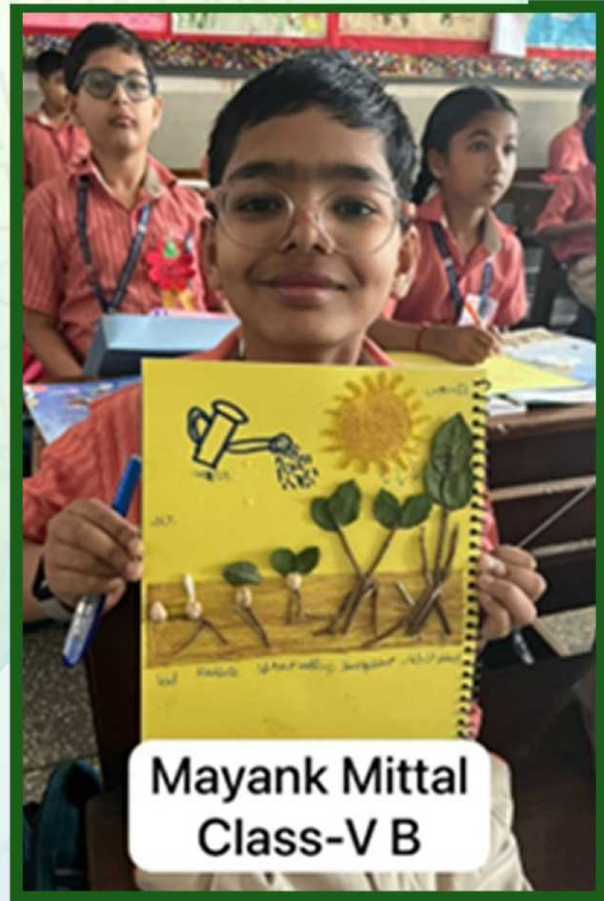
An activity was conducted in class 9 to study the properties of particles of matter. Students demonstrated the process of diffusion using potassium permanganate and water

**"Sow the Seed"** activity by students of class V Showed the different stages of seed germination using the real seeds of gram / beans and learnt the concept of seed germination.

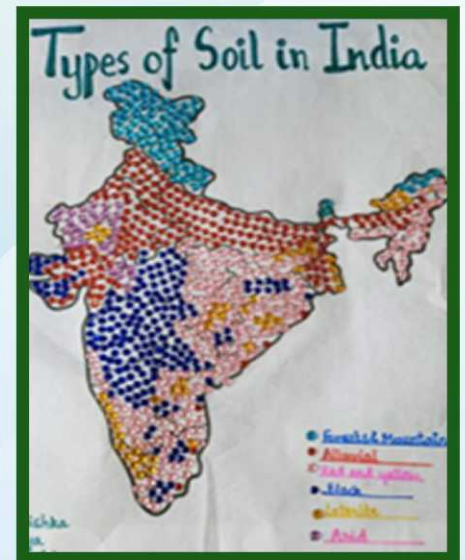
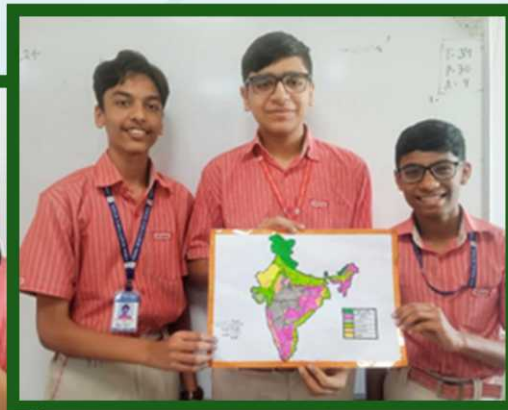


## The Joy of Learning by doing

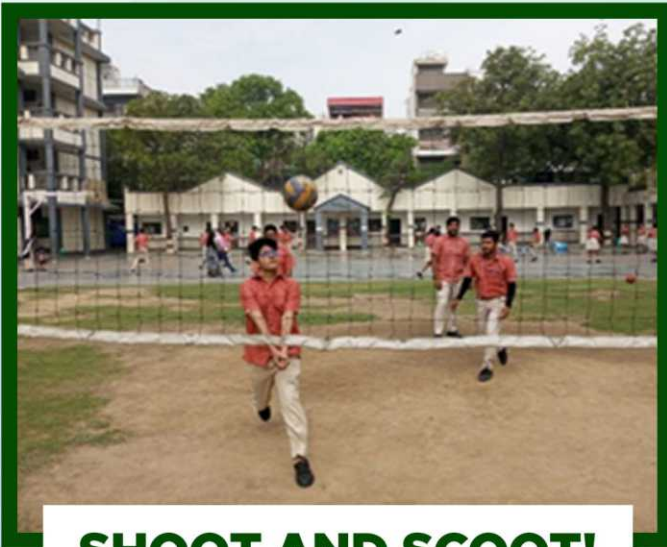

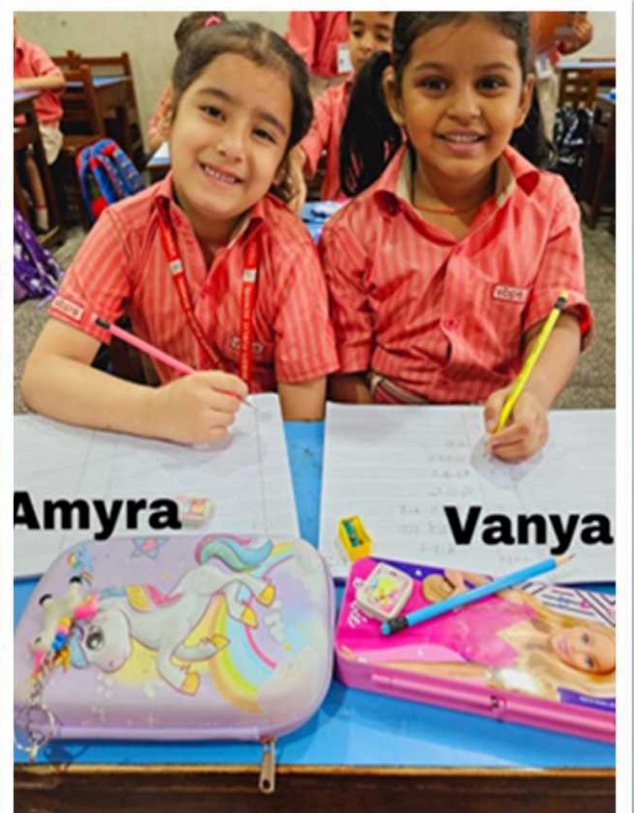

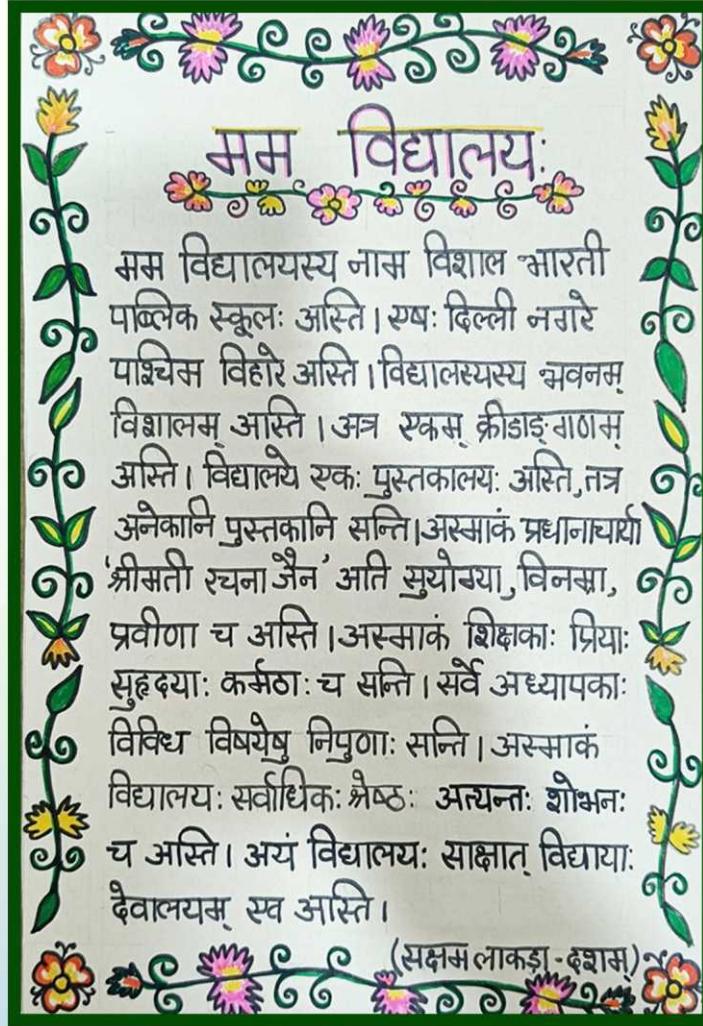
विद्यालय में अनुशासन जहां। है मर्यादित विद्यार्थी वहां॥

Plus trois petits grains de sable...

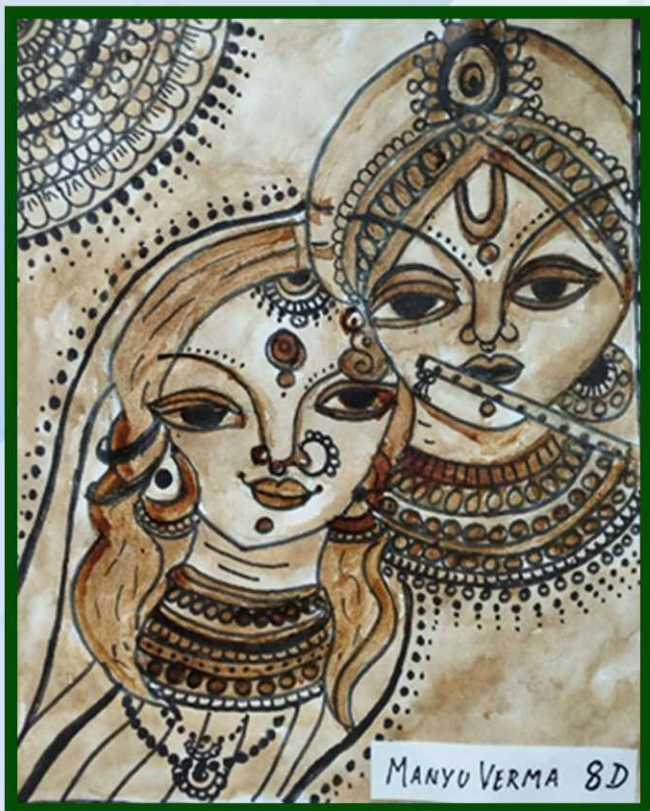
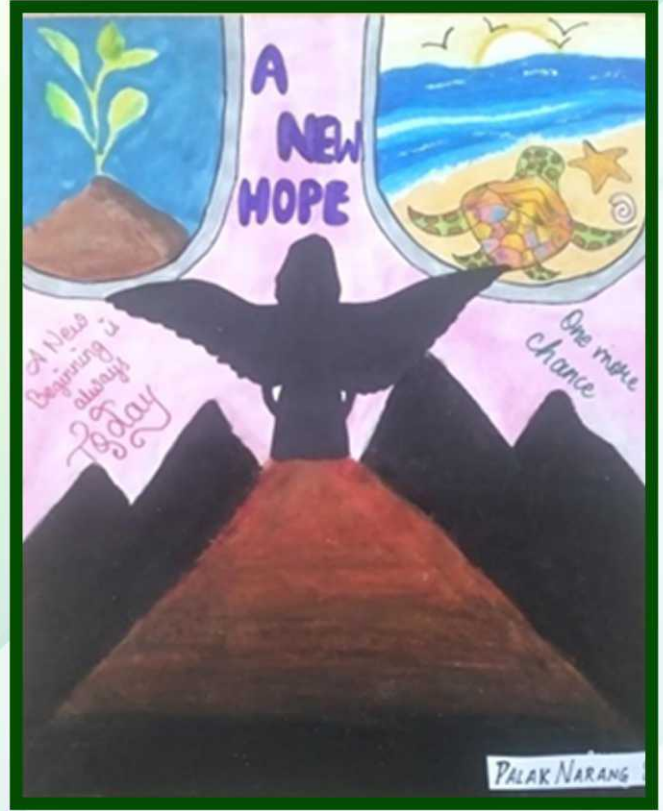

And the beach portico.

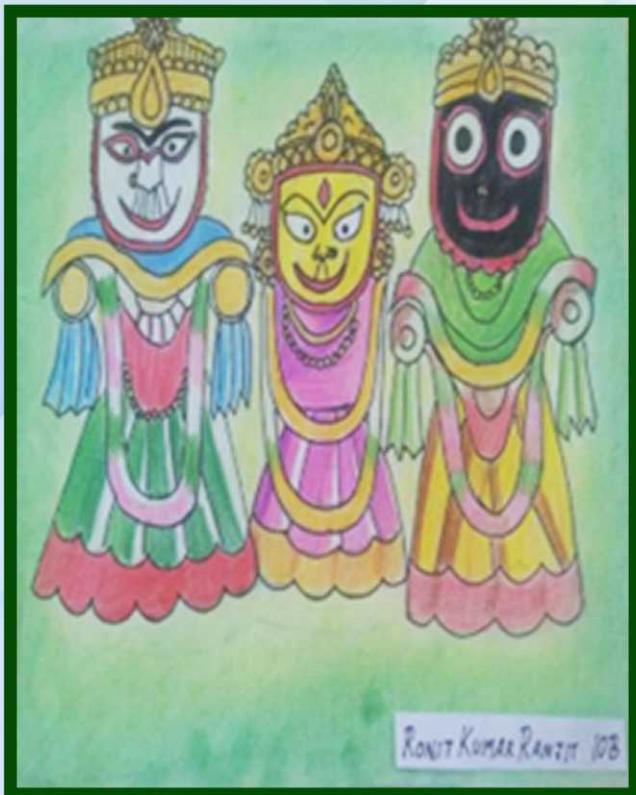
